

## Policy on Distribution:

Our normal distribution period begins at 8:00 am on a Saturday, ending at 10:00 am. If weather, mechanical, or unforeseen problems force a delay, then we will not begin later than 3:00 pm Saturday. If we are unable to begin by 3:00 pm Saturday, then distribution will be rescheduled for 3:00 p.m. of the next day, Sunday. If we are unable to begin on Sunday, then distribution will be delayed for one week until the following Saturday. If that fails, the next course of action will be posted at Blessed Sacrament and be available by calling the church office, (714) 528-2995. Angel Food must be picked up during the actual distribution period, whether normal or rescheduled, and this is a condition of sale. Blessed Sacrament is not responsible for the loss of food not claimed during an actual distribution.

It is exciting to know that in every box of food that is distributed, the word of God is shared along with a personal invitation to accept Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. Angel Food Ministries was founded on fulfilling the great commission as given by Jesus Christ in Matthew 28: 18-20

*Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup>Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup>and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. Angel Food Ministries is a non-profit, non-denominational organization that sells high-quality food through host site churches in over 3,000 communities in 35 states.

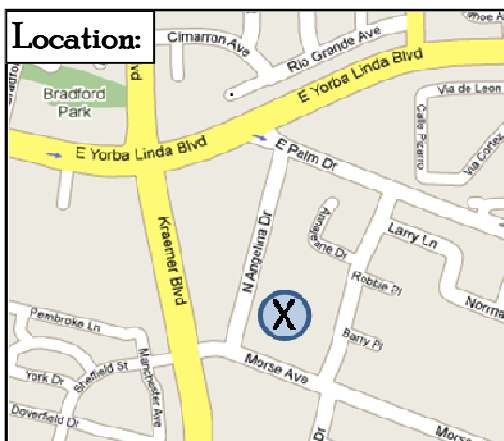


Angel Food provides grocery relief to people in our community by helping them stretch their food dollars.

The deadlines for ordering are shown on the chart above. A receptionist will normally be on duty in the Parish Office On Tuesday 9:00 am to noon; Wednesday 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm & Thursday 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm, the week prior to the ordering deadline each month.

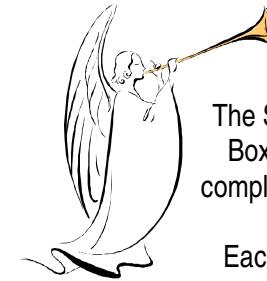
You may pay the receptionist with cash, a check, money order or Food Stamps for the exact amount. Credit cards are not accepted for in-person orders.

Full payment is required at the time of ordering.

When Ordering please give us:

- Name of person or persons who will pick up the order.
- Telephone number and/or e-mail address in case we need to contact you.



The Basic Unit is a great value for only \$30.

The Senior Box or Convenience Box contains ten fully-cooked complete individual meals for \$28!

Each month there are Add-On Special Boxes as well.

- The Basic Unit serves a family of four for about a week or one person for nearly a month.
- Food in the program requires cooking facilities and frozen storage.
- Full payment is required when ordering. The deadline for ordering is in the chart to the left.
- Angel Food will be delivered by truck and distributed at blessed Sacrament Church on days shown in chart at the left. **PICK UPS MUST BE MADE BETWEEN 8:00 A.M. AND 10:00 A.M.**
- **MOST ITEMS ARE FROZEN AND WE DO NOT HAVE FREEZER SPACE TO STORE IT. Food not picked up by 10:00 am will be donated to a charity without refund to the purchaser.**
